Consent Agenda

The meeting was called to order at 4:10 pm

There was a roll call taken with Commissioners Toolson, Richardson, Manning, Fisher, Yankovich and Houston in attendance.

Commissioner Duarte is absent.

New Business

There was discussion on the Bylaws and Commissioner Toolson moved to approve the Bylaws and Commissioner Fisher seconded. A roll call was taken with all in approval.

Jennifer Yost and Larry Richardson talked about the application for the façade program and what the Commission wanted to do with it. Commissioner Manning moved to approve the proposal to city council that the façade program be a 5 year forgivable loan and Commissioner Houston seconded. A roll call was taken with all in approval.

Morgan Treasure gave a brief overview of what the Mainstreet approach is. She spoke about this commission being heavily involved with the design committee.

Updates

Jennifer Yost gave an update on the façade program. There is about \$32,000.00 left in the fund available for a grant. If there is no interest by September of 2017 it will go back into the general CDBG fund.

There was discussion about the PIX and what the update on that is. Morgan treasure gave an update.

Open Discussion

Per e-mail, Commissioner Duarte shared that there would be a free grant writing workshop to any interested at her studio May 18th at 7:00 pm.

There was discussion about what was happening downtown. The Nampa Art Collective has some activities set up. May 13th is the Art Bomb. Canyon County historical society is going to be doing an art event at the train depot in August.

A Skaug Law representative let the commission know the lack of art and thought to the new "Nampa Proud" logo with the city as a whole. It was discussed that it was a community effort and not a city specific effort. The commission discussed the desire to see other options. Commissioner Houston said he would wear his Pocatello Pride shirt next meeting. This was based off of the Pure Michigan and New Mexico True. The Commission would like to discuss this more next meeting and get more information.

Review Action Items

Maps of downtown districts were provided and given a history on the downtown districts by Jennifer Yost.

All need to do homework on what other cities are doing and what can be done in ours.

The comprehensive plan for 2006 was provided.


The Commission would like the new sidewalk plan.
