I. **Welcome.** With LaRita being absent (Adam arrived late), Eualeen Beukelman opened the meeting at 4:00 P.M.

2. **Approval of minutes of the previous meeting.** The minutes were approved as presented with no corrections. Motion to approve was made by Phil Peterson and seconded by Meggan Manlove.

3. **Additions or changes to the agenda.** 12th Ave crossing, TAP (Transportation Alternative Program) grants and bike count locations added.

COMMUNICATIONS

4. **Project Updates,** Jeff Barnes updated us on upcoming projects affecting bicycles and pedestrians in Nampa. (Details on attached maps)

- Wilson Trail HAWK Crossings: Design underway, Spring FY17 Construction
- Stoddard Trail HAWK and Parking Lot: Design complete, Fall FY17 Construction
- Bike and Walk Phase 2: Design underway, Spring FY17 Construction
- Nampa & Skyview HS Improvements: Design underway, Spring FY17 Construction. (includes pathway in front of school, previously discussed)

- Amity Chestnut HAWK: Design complete, Summer FY16 Construction
- 12th Ave HAWK Crossings: Design underway, Spring FY17 Construction at Sherman.

Another possible future crossing was discussed; placing a crossing on 12th Ave S at either 10th, 11th or 12th St. There is a bus stop at 12th but that could be moved if need be. Consensus was that 11th would be the best and it is on our plan as a bike route.

Roads being marked for cycling were discussed and questions clarified.

The bicycle corral at the library has been installed.

OLD BUSINESS

5. **Count Locations.** Access to the library was discussed and it was noted that we need to count at the 12th Ave S/ 2nd St intersection. Adam mentioned counting at the new downtown pathway by Front St.

NEW BUSINESS

6. **TAP Project Recommendation** to submit an application for funding to fill the gap in the Indian Creek Trail and improvements in cycling and pedestrian facilities on Sherman Rd and to submit a letters of support from the NBPAC and Bike/Walk Nampa. Motion to approve by Bruce Wiley, seconded by Phil Peterson.



FY17 Zone B Proposed Work Draft 1


