1. New Business

1.1 Approve June 8th, 2020 minutes – **Action Item**

***MOTION:** Commissioner Wormser moved to accept the minutes as presented. Commission Manning accepted. The motion passed unanimously.*

1.2 Discussion about supporting Susan Montierth, owner of the Hasbrouck House, on a National Register of Historic Places nomination – **Action Item**

Susan Montierth, owner of the Hasbrouck House, talked about the history of the property and different uses the building has had since she acquired it 2011 and expressed interest in nominating it to the National Register of Historic Places. Staff presented the documentation on the property provided by SHPO and presented this as an opportunity to use the 2020 CLG grant funds that will not be used for travel expenses to the NAPC Forum & Idaho Heritage Conference.

1.3 Reallocation of 2020 CLG grant dollars– **Action Item**

***MOTION:** Commissioner Wormser moved to reallocate the 2020 CLG grant dollars to support a nomination of the Hasbrouck house to the National Register of Historic Places. Commissioner Manning seconded. The motion passed unanimously.*

1.4 Review and recommend finalized 2020 Historic Preservation Plan to Nampa City Council for adoption – **Action Item**

Staff presented the final pieces of the Historic Preservation Plan to the Commission for approval.

MOTION: *Commissioner Volkert moved to recommend adoption of the Historic Preservation Plan to City Council on August 3. Commissioner Wormser seconded. The motion passed unanimously.*

2. Open Discussion-

The commission discussed the negative impacts that the COVID-19 pandemic is having on the art world. There have been limited gallery opportunities. Some venues are providing virtual gallery tours. Music Theater of Idaho is making adjustments with the hopes of being able to have social-distanced in-person performances.
