Reminder of Irrigation Assessment Deadline

(June 27, 2013) The last day for Nampa property owners to pay their Nampa Municipal Irrigation Assessment without disruption of service or penalty is June 30, 2013. Crews will begin pressurized irrigation shut-offs for non-payment July 15th.

Accounts not paid by June 30th are subject to a penalty, monthly interest, a \$25 service charge, along with the possibility of shut-off for non-payment.

Last year more than 1700 customers had irrigation services shut-off due to non-payment. Property owners should be aware it can take up to a week from the time the late payment is received to turn the irrigation water back on.

Customers can pay the irrigation assessment online by adding the account to their online payment options (instruction are on the page and easy to follow), pay in person at 401 3rd Street South between 8:30 am and 5pm, send the payment by mail, (must be postmarked by June 30th to avoid shut-off and penalties), or over the phone by calling 649-1288 (please note there is a \$1.50 fee for this service.)

Please Remember

- ⇒ Irrigation Assessments are due **June 30, 2013**
- ⇒ Service shutoffs will begin on July 15, 2013
- ⇒ Fees and penalties will apply to past due balances
- ⇒ It can take up to 7 days from the date a late payment is received to turn irrigation water back on

Payment can be made to Utility Billing in person at 401 3rd St. S., by regular mail if postmarked by June 30, or by phone at 208-649-1288 for a \$1.50 service charge. If you have questions regarding your account, or the irrigation shutoff policy, Utility Billing is available to answer these questions at 208-468-5711.
