Cost: FREE with proof of Nampa residency (i.e. utility bill)

Tire sizes up to 16.5 inches will be accepted. No commercial tires will be accepted. Please remove all rims from tires. Tires must come from residential properties and not businesses.

This is an effort to help citizens remove old tires from their property, which can be both a code violation and a health hazard.

- Remove rims from tires
- Tires should be free of dirt & mud.

### Tire Collection Guidelines

- **FREE for Nampa residents (MUST HAVE PROOF OF RESIDENCY)**
- **Automotive Tires - sizes up to 16 1/2 inches will be accepted.**
- **Tires must be separated from rim and free of dirt or mud.**
- **Tires must be from residential properties, absolutely no tires from businesses.**

### Tire Facts

- One of the most promising ways to recycle tires is by turning them into ground rubber "crumbs" and adding them to asphalt for paving roads, running tracks & playgrounds. Pavement life can be increased by 4 to 5 years this way.
- Americans discard 280 million tires a year, 25 to 30% of which are re-treaded or otherwise reused.
- About 8 out of 10 tires in the U.S. wind up in landfills or "stockpiles". An estimated 2 to 3 billion tires are currently stockpiled in the United States.
- Check your tire pressure! If all tires in America were properly inflated, we could save two billion gallons of gasoline.
- When old tires are left outside, they can collect rainwater, making them the perfect breeding ground for mosquitoes.
