

COMMON PARKING VIOLATIONS

- Parking Where Official Signs Prohibit,
- Overtime Parking (parking in excess of the time posted),
- Parking in a leased/rented stall,
- Double Parked (parked over the lines or taking up more than one space),
- Backed into a diagonal parking space,
- Parked Blocking Driveway,
- Parking on Sidewalk,
- Parked in an Alley,
- Parked within 25 feet of a corner,
- Parked in a no parking zone,
- Parked within 15 feet of a fire hydrant,
- Parked Headed or Facing the wrong direction,
- Parked on or within 20' of a crosswalk,
- Parked with the wheels over 18 inches from the curb,
- Parked within 20' of a stop sign, flashing beacon, or traffic control signal,
- Parked in a fire lane or along any yellow or red painted curb,
- Trucks and/or commercial vehicles parking in prohibited zones,
- Parked in a City Park after sunset,
- Parked or driving on grass,
- Unauthorized parking in an accessible handicap stall or adjacent access aisle,
- Parked on a bike lane or bike path,
- Camper, motor-home or trailer parked on the street for more than 72 hours,
- Parked in a residential area where a permit is required,
- Failure to display property parking permit,
- Removal of chalk marks,
- Parking in front yard setbacks for more than forty-eight hours,
- Temporary Parking Use Permit Violation,
